

Job Title: Good Food Program and Kitchen Support

FoodShare's Good Food Programs include a fresh produce distribution warehouse, a commercial kitchen, mobile produce markets, and community-run Good Food Markets. We are hiring **2 Good Food Program and Kitchen Support positions** to support these programs. This job includes rotating through these work areas as needed to support FoodShare's vision of providing good, healthy food to communities across Toronto.

Responsibilities

- Assist with food preparation and clean up in our kitchen
- Support correct completion of paperwork related to packing and inventory
- Load and unload product onto and off of skids by hand, or by using basic material handling equipment such as a pump truck
- Maintain and organize inventory
- Assist the drivers with route planning, deliveries and customer service
- Prepare, pack and complete orders according to written instructions
- Receive and process warehouse stock products (pick, unload, label, store)
- Maintain a safe and clean work environment by keeping all work areas clean
- Perform inventory controls and maintain high quality assurance standards
- Communicate and collaborate with supervisors and coworkers

Qualifications and Skills:

- Strong reading comprehension and written and verbal communication skills
- Teamwork oriented and positive "can-do" attitude
- Good organizational and time management skills
- Able to start as early as 7 am, work in the afternoons, evenings and weekends, as required
- Ability to work at a quick and steady pace
- Ability to be on your feet for 8 hours and to lift a maximum of 50lbs and willingness to do repetitive work

Assets:

- Food Handlers Certificate, Warehouse Experience, Picker/Packer Experience, First aid, Valid driver's license G

This position is funded through the Canada Summer Jobs Program and requires that the applicant:

- Is between 15-30 years of age (inclusive)
- Was registered as a full-time student during the last academic year
- Intends to return to school on a full time basis during the next academic year
- Is a student in a post-secondary, vocational or technical program
- Is a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act
- Is legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial legislation and regulations
