

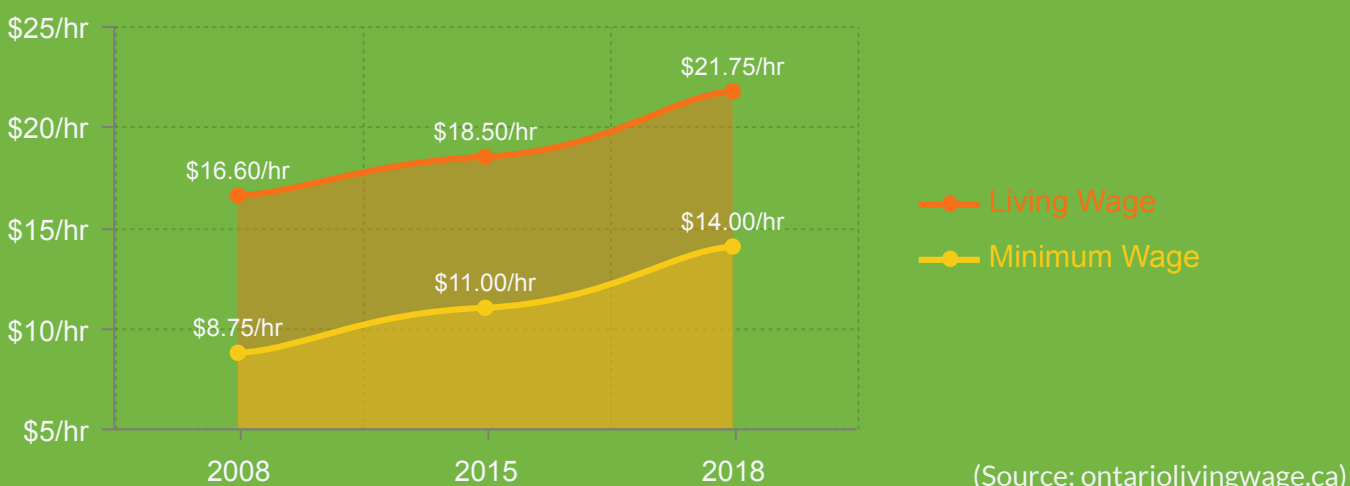
Good Food & Good Jobs in School Cafeterias
